



IFAGG Council release 5.3.2022

The IFAGG Council held a meeting 4.3.2022 to discuss worlds situation and President Liliya Morozovas proposal to step back temporarily from her position.

The IFAGG Council approved the president to step back from her position, and according to the statutes point 9.2.2, when president is unable to carry her duties, the vice presidents shall take over until further notice.

In their discussion IFAGG Council considered the latest recommendations from the International Olympic Committee (IOC) and decided on following points:

- **Competitions and events: no IFAGG sanctioned competitions in Russia and Belarus are allowed until further notice.**
- **Teams from Russia and Belarus Federations: no participation of Russian and Belarussian teams in IFAGG sanctioned competitions if required by the organizing country restrictions until further notice.**
- **Teams from Russia and Belarus Federations: not allowed to use national emblems, flags, anthems in IFAGG sanctioned competitions until further notice.**
- **Officials from Russia and Belarus: no participation of Russian and Belarussian officials in IFAGG organized events until further notice.**

IFAGG condemns the war and the council continues to monitor the situation closely and to evaluate the need of possible further actions.

The IFAGG Council clarified that overall world cup and challenge cup series points are not counted during the whole year 2022 (not only WC I and CC I). The Council also decided that in this situation with covid/post-covid and war in Ukraine, World Cup and Challenge Cup I-III/2022 are recognized with WC/CC official status even if minimum 3 countries participate.
