



INTERNATIONAL JUDGING SYSTEM

Judging license system

<p>1st LEVEL international judge - judging test – written and practical Gives you the right to act: as a judging instructor (Council decision), as a head judge, as the Responsible judge and sit in the Superior Jury</p>
<p>Passed the Deep technique course for Aesthetic Group Gymnastics</p>
<p>Requirements: Level 2 judging license for at least 2 (two) years. Wide national judging experience. Minimum of 5 (five) international competitions that IFAGG Council has approved (A-cat.) after level 2 exam</p>
<p>2nd LEVEL international judge - judging test – written and practical Gives you the right to act: as a national judging instructor and as an international judge</p>
<p>Passed the Deep technique course for Aesthetic Group Gymnastics</p>
<p>Requirements: Level 3 judging license at least 2 (two) years. Minimum of 4 (four) International competitions that IFAGG Council has approved (A-cat.) after level 3 exam</p>
<p>3th LEVEL international judge - judging test – written and practical Gives you the right to act: as an international judge</p>
<p>Passed the International judges' course for Aesthetic Group Gymnastics, level 3</p>
<p>National judging experience</p>
<p>IFAGG member</p>

- ❑ Judge can renew their licence at the international judging course
- ❑ Judging licence system would contain a total of about 100 – 130 hours.
For example

3d level: 30 h judging course + Pre-exercises and basics of AGG techniques 20 h

2d level: 15 h judging course + distance exercises and deep technical course of AGG 15 h

1st level: 15 h judging course + distance exercises and deep technical course of AGG 15 h

For Licence to be active

Judge must participate in a minimum of 1 competition (minimum category B) within one year of passing the judges exam (level). Otherwise, the judging license becomes invalid.

If there are no competitions during the 1-year period (counted from when the judges license exam was passed), the judge must re-take the course and re-take the exam in order to renew the license.

Substitution of AGG judging licence requirements

International AGG judging license requirements cannot be substituted with licensing from another sport or any experience from other similar sports. Everyone has to pass the official courses and exams of the IFAGG judging license system.

Reduction or loss of Judging level

All international IFAGG judges must participate in the IFAGG International Judging Course every other year and in order to keep their license they must participate as judge in a minimum of 1 international B level competition. If not, the IFAGG Judge will lose 1 level each year. The only exceptions are outlined in the IFAGG Judging Regulations

1st level → 2nd level

2nd level → 3th level

3th level → will lose international level
